GENERAL COUNCIL

Call to Order – Nancy Houlihan

Mission Statement: Sharing our Lord's Word, we: Make disciples; love God and neighbor, grow in God's grace and knowledge; glorify God!

Devotions—Pastor Laura – Read excerpts from "Look Up" and "We Rise Higher" books that will be given as Confirmation gifts and High School Graduation gifts.

Council Secretary's Report—Approval via email.

Financial Secretary's Report—Mary presented her report, General offering \$12,760.34, Globe \$80.40, Youth \$40.00, Interest \$8.33, Wednesday Meals \$284.00 and Other Giving (Easter Lilies) \$39.00. Total Deposit \$13,232.07. Tim made a motion to approve the financial report, Harold seconded, the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – From Wendy's report, Total All Giving \$13,187.07 which is below the Budget of \$23,929.72. YTD Total All Giving: \$22,418.06, which is below the Budget of \$38,208.24. Expenses \$16,869.80 below the Budget of \$18,037.44. Expenses YTD \$32,167.51 which is lower than Budget of \$35,252.99. Looking ahead, our insurance will be increasing along with the cost of our garbage service. Tim made a motion to approve the Treasurer report, Deanne seconded, the motion carried.

Pastor's Report - Since our last Council Meeting:

Lenten Round Robins have been going very well and have been well received at all participating churches.

Visitations and prayers have continued for our members who are ill or have been hospitalized.

Pastor Laura offered a First Communion instruction class on Saturday, March 16th for 3 individuals who will receive First Communion at our Maundy Thursday Service on March 28th at 6:30.

Pastor Laura also presented to the Council a plan to have our next years Confirmation class of 2 individuals join with West Nidaros Confirmation class. Everyone agreed that it would be a good idea.

Pastor Laura will be attending the Crossroads Conference in Brookings on April 2nd, 3rd and 4th.

The Confirmation Class will meet on April 24th from 7-8 pm to rehearse and turn in their projects and will be confirmed on Sunday, April 28,2024.

We will honor our High School Graduates during our church service on May 5, 2024. Our graduates are: Rylan Aman, Gavin Johnson, Bailey Schipper and Chase Obbink. Mary made a motion to approve the Pastor's report and Amy seconded, the motion carried.


MARCH MEN IN MISSION


