The Men in Mission made lovely faith chests for them, a lady from our congregation made a cloth embroidered with a cross for them, and money was used from the milestone ministry line in our budget to purchase a Lutheran keepsake board book about

baptism and their certificates and candles! Thank you for your generosity!

The Adult Supper Club organized by Judy Classen was well attended and I believe that we will meet again on March 18. Restaurant to be determined!

I have had regular visits with folks from our congregation who have been hospitalized or are shut in.

The Northern Rim Youth are hosting a banquet again this year to cover the cost of transportation to camp.
