



#### Lemon Dill Fish

1/2 C. Miracle Whip 1 tsp. dill weed 2Tbl. Lemon juice fish fillets such as: Cod, flounder or catfish 1/2 tsp. grated lemon peel



New congregation who had just gotten into their first church building.
