Call to Order – Harold Ahlers

Council Secretary's Report—Approval via email.

Financial Secretary's Report—Mary presented her report, General offering \$16,544.00, Globe \$297.17, Youth \$45.00, Interest \$8.79. Total Deposit \$16,894.96. Tim made a motion to approve the financial reports, Nancy seconded, the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – From Wendy's report, Total All Giving \$16,894.96 which is above the Budget of \$13,010.30. YTD Total All Giving \$195,441.01, which is above the Budget of \$154,345.31. Expenses \$13,168.27 less than Budget of \$14,626.56, Expenses YTD \$178,934.45 which is lower than Budget of \$182,405.02. Rahn made a motion to approve the Treasurer report, Nancy seconded, the motion carried.

Pastor's Report – Since our last Council Meeting:

Pastor attended a Boundaries Workshop.

Visitations have continued for our shut ins as well as those who are ill and in need of prayer.

Pastor Laura provided feedback regarding all of our Christmas Services; Our service on The Longest night was well attended, not just by our congregation, but Pastors and members from our neighboring churches as well. Both services on Christmas Eve were well attended and Pastor suggested that we consider having two services on Christmas Eve going forward. Mary made a motion to approve the Pastor's report, David seconded, the motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Board of Education

Sunday School will resume on January 7, 2024, and it will be a very exciting day for the teachers and children! They will be deciding how best to spend the Globe Offering funds of \$1066.70 as this amount will not only allow them to purchase the farm, but will allow them to decide what additional animals they should buy to complete the farm. 
