

Additional parts need to be replaced for an estimate of \$2,500-\$3,000. Formal bid will be acquired prior to making final decision. If you have been considering becoming more involved there are 2 openings on council, secretary and President Elect.



Norwegian Meatballs

2 Lbs ground beef 3/4 C. milk 1/2 lb pork sausage

1 small onion grated 2 slices of bread 2 tsp. salt

Gravy: 3 1/2 C water 2 tsp salt

pepper to taste 1/2 C flour

Soak bread in milk (old is best); mix thoroughly. Add remaining ingredients. Form into balls and brown in skillet. For gravy, the water, salt, flour and pepper. Thicken with scant tsp Kitchen Bouquet. Pour over meatballs and bake in oven about an hour at 350 degrees.
