## **Council Minutes – June 5, 2023**

**Present:** Pastor Laura, Harold Ahlers, Rahn Siemonsma, Deanne Kracht, Amanda Dieren, Mike Eggers, Mary Lei, Natalie Lavender, , Tim Eggers, Nancy Houlihan, Wendy Madson and Faye Berghorst.

Call to Order: - Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by President, Harold Ahlers.

**Devotions: Harold Ahlers** – Servanthood.

Council Secretary Report: Approved via email.

#### **Financial Secretary Report:**

General offering - \$8846.00, Globe - \$20.00, Interest \$16.63, Memorial \$370.00, Sunday School - \$24.00, Youth - \$40.00, Other Giving \$0, Total Deposit for May \$9316.63.

Motion made by Rahn, second by Mike to approve and place on file, motion passed.

#### Treasurer's Report:

Total All Giving for May was \$9316.63, which was lower than Budget of \$10,071.50.

YTD Total All Giving: \$99,388.68, which is higher than Budget of \$65,862.13.

Expenses for May were \$21,695.27, which was higher than Budget of \$14,671.45.

YTD Expenses: \$82,419.94, which is higher than Budget of \$76,788.40.

- Wendy presented COD Options. Rahn proposed that we take the \$14,000.00 in our Endowment fund and put it in a 6 month COD at 4.1% to help grow that fund, and also Rahn proposed that we take \$20,000.00 from our General Checking account and invest in a 3-month COD at 4% interest in an effort to grow our funds so that the interest earned could be utilized for either other giving or unexpected expenses in the future. If at the end of the terms, interest is still the same amounts or higher, we can evaluate and possibly reinvest as Council sees fit.
- Motion made by Rahn, second by Harold to move forward with a vote by the other Council members. After discussion, the Motion passed to move said funds to COD's at amounts noted above.
- Motion made by Tim, second by Mike to approve and place on file, motion passed.

#### **Pastor's Report:**

Pastor Laura attended the Fesitival of Homiletics in May and attended Synod Assemble with Sandy Sorum. Pastor Laura covered services at St. Dysmas for that attending Pastor's vacation.

Pastor Laura has had regular visits with folks from our congregation who have been hospitalized or are shut in.

- Wednesday Boost Services will begin this week. A Bible Study will be offered after the Wednesday Boost services starting on June 14, and will continue on June 21 and 28,2023.

It began in North Carolina with 10 men who contributed \$100 each (equivalent to \$1750 today) to develop an outreach program for future churches. Thanks Pastor Laura for sharing this article with us. We also discussed our own outreach program in the Renner community. Ideas were shared such as helping with a booth at the Renner Days in August. Maybe there will be pamphlets to hand out explaining the Renner Lutheran church ministry as well as shirts with the Renner Church logo to wear and sell during that event and future events. ## Cream Puff Dessert

1 stick real butter3.5 C. cold milk1 tub whipped cream1 C. flour1 C. chopped nuts1 C. water4 eggs1-8 oz. cream cheese, softened2 small boxes instant chocolate puddingchocolate and caramel sauceIn a saucepan, melt butter in water. Dump in flour all at once: mix well. Letthe dough sit for 5-7 minutes to cool down. All one egg at a time, mixing wellafter each one. Spread dough in 9x13" pan and bake at 350 degrees for20-30 minutes until crust is golden brown. Let cool. Mix together creamcheese, milk and pudding mix; pout into cooled crust. Top with whippedcream. Drizzle chocolate sauce and caramel sauce on top. Add chopped

nuts, if desired.
