- Council Secretary's Report—Approval via email.
- Financial Secretary's Report—Mary presented her report, General offering \$9,112.00, Globe \$34.00, Youth \$0, Interest \$9.99. Total Deposit \$9,230.99. Wendy made a motion to approve the financial report, Harold seconded, the motion carried.

 - Pastor Laura performed the funeral service for Jay Lavender, son of John and Natalie Lavender on Monday, January 22.
 - Ash Wednesday Service on February 14th will be held here at Renner Lutheran at 6:30.
 - Our Church will once again participate in the Round Robin Lenten Services with several of our neighboring churches. Beginning on February 21st and ending on March 20th, we will serve a light supper at 5:30 and worship will follow at 6:30 each Wednesday evening. There will be a signup sheet in the Fellowship Hall if you would like to sign up to bring a meal on one of those evenings.
 - The Hope of Easter Booklets have been ordered and will be placed on the tables in each entryway and given to each family at our Sunday School Easter Egg Hunt.


