#### Norwegian Apple Cake

1/2 C. shortening
1 C, sugar
1 tsp. salt
2 tsp. baking powder

2 eggs 1 C. milk

1 tsp. vanilla peeled cored apples 2 1/2 C. flour Cinnamon/sugar topping

Cream shortening and sugar. Add beaten eggs and vanilla. Add dry ingredients alternately with the milk. Spread in large greased and floured pan. Top with apple slices, placed in rows. Sprinkle with 2 teaspoons cinnamon mixed with 1 cup sugar; more or less of this topping to taste. Bake 340 degrees for 45 minutes
